***8* MOTION — (HON. DANIEL BURCHA- MEMBER LAISAMIS WARD)**

Mr. Speaker Sir, Pursuant to Standing Order 44 (1) I beg to give notice of the following motion that:

AWARE THAT Article 174 of the Constitution recognizes the need of taking development to the smallest units of devolution; **FURTHER AWARE THAT** Article 202 promotes equitable development across all wards and allow participation of residents of each county and respective wards in the identification of priority projects; **COGNIZANT** of the efforts of the successive County Government of Marsabit to ensure decentralization of resources within the County; **FURTHER COGNIZANT** of the efforts of the Second County Assembly of Marsabit to introduce the Marsabit County Ward Development Fund Bill 2022; **CONCERNED THAT** the ward allocations have been inconsistent/decreasing over the years and skewed resulting in uneven development of the wards; **NOTING THAT** there is no clear formula in place for the distribution of resources amongst the 20 Wards in Marsabit; **FURTHER NOTING THAT** the decentralization of resources to the ward level is critical for the continued development of every ward and particularly honoring and recognizing the power of self-governance of the people in identifying their priorities for the respective wards during public participation over the Annual Budget Estimates; **FURTHER NOTING THAT** nothing bars the County Assembly from enacting a Marsabit County Ward Development Fund; **NOW THEREFORE** I urge this House to consider enacting a legislation that will ensure the fair and equitable distribution of resources to the ward level.
